TRAFFIC SIGNAGE CHANGE HORNSBY STREET

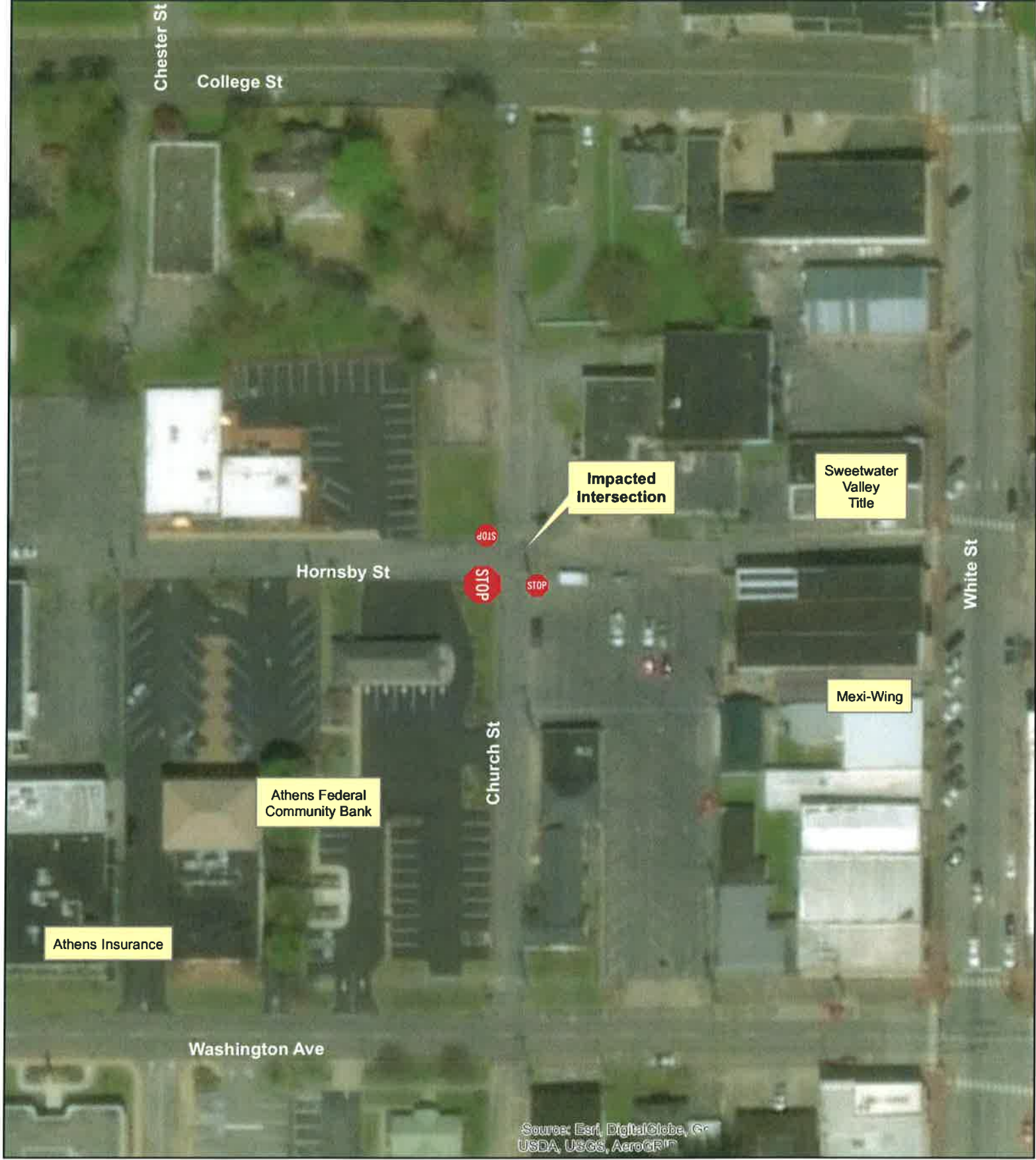
ATHENS, TENNESSEE – March, 20, 2018 – The City of Athens Public Works Department announces an important change in the signage at the intersection of Hornsby Street and Church Street.

Currently at the intersection of HORNSBY STREET and CHURCH STREET there are STOP signs located on Church Street only. Effective Wednesday, March 21, 2018 there will be a STOP sign in place on the EASTBOUND SIDE OF HORNSBY STREET. This will make the intersection a 3-WAY STOP and improve safety at this intersection.

Motorists are advised to watch for new signage and to use caution when traveling in the area.
