PERMANENT STREET CLOSURE AND LANE MODIFICATION
COLLEGE STREET / TENNESSEE WESLEYAN UNIVERSITY

ATHENS, TENNESSEE – May 8, 2018 – The City of Athens Public Works Department announces the following permanent street closure and lane modification:

The areas to be affected are COLLEGE STREET from Jackson Street to Long Street and the RIGHT HAND LANE ON JACKSON STREET from Washington Avenue to College Street. The right hand lane on Jackson Street will no longer be a right hand turn lane. The three lanes on Jackson Street from Washington Avenue to College Street will be modified to two through lanes only. College Street from Jackson Street to Long Street will be permanently closed to through traffic. This closure will be effective on Monday, May 21, 2018 at 8:00 a.m.

Motorists are advised to use extreme caution and watch for traffic signage and pedestrians. Motorists should allocate additional time for traffic delays when traveling in this area.

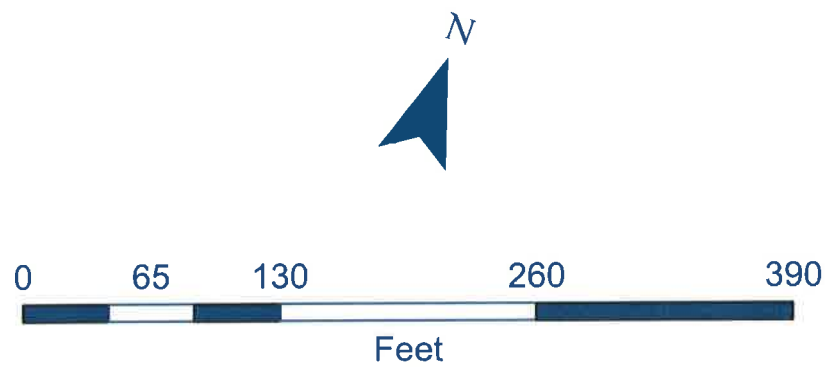
The City of Athens is a full-service municipality nestled in the foothills of the Great Smoky Mountains and has garnered a reputation as the “Friendly City.”
