#### GIS MAPPING ACTIVITIES STATE ROUTES

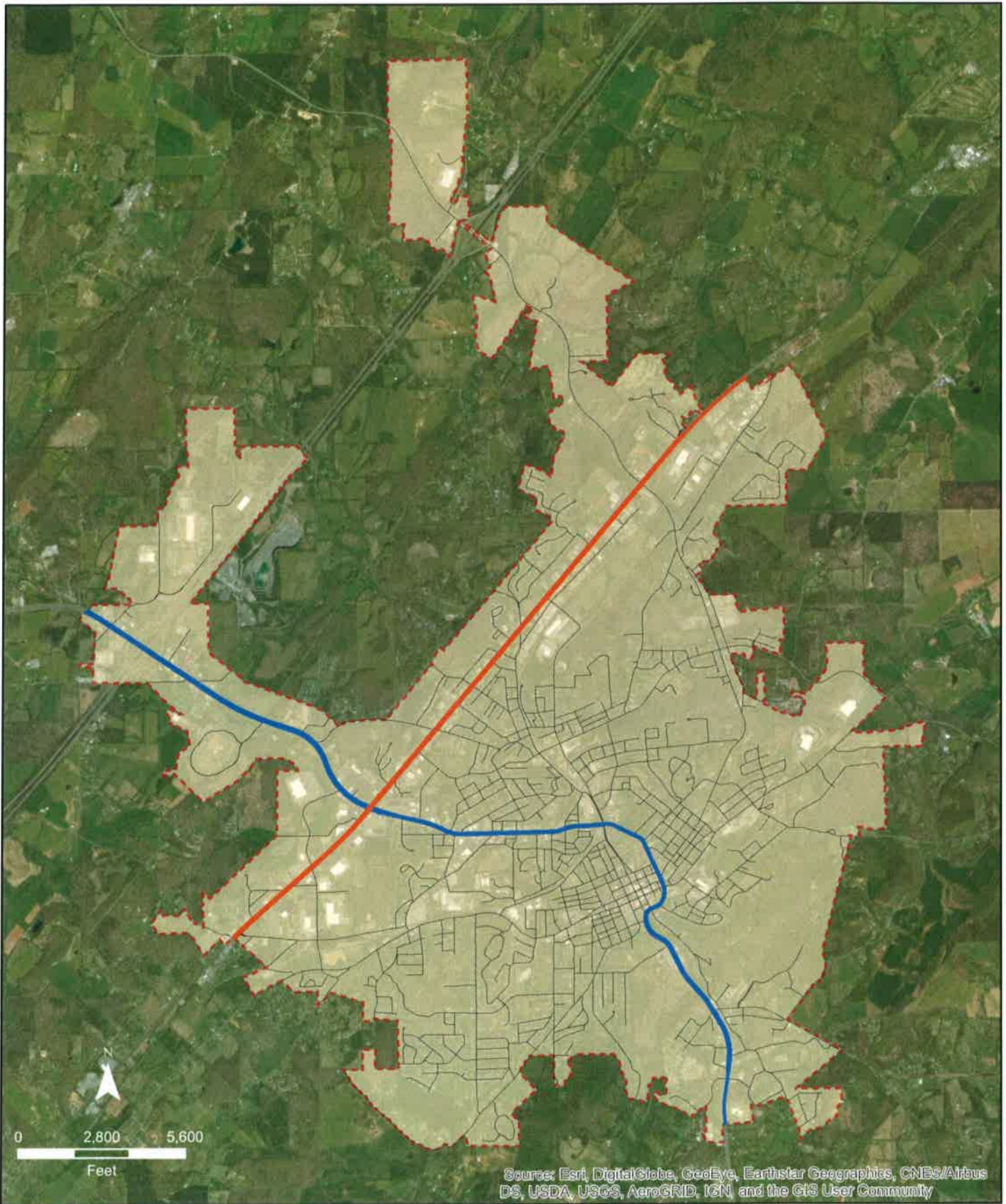
ATHENS, TENNESSEE – May 9, 2018 – The City of Athens Public Works Department announces the following GIS Activities:

The City of Athens Department of Public Works advises the residents and business owners of the following ongoing program. The City of Athens Geographical Information System Technician is performing stormwater data collection over various area of the city during the next several weeks. The GIS Technician will be working along state rights-of-way and medians in an effort to map stormwater drains, culverts, catch basins, and retention/detention ponds. The City of Athens will issue press releases periodically in an effort to keep the public informed as to the data collection areas.

The current areas of data collection are State Route 11 (Congress Parkway) and State Route 30 (Decatur Pike).
