STREET CLOSING TECHNOLOGY WAY

ATHENS, TENNESSEE – September 5, 2018 – The City of Athens Public Works Department announces the following street closure:

The area to be affected is the two way portion of TECHNOLOGY WAY from Congress Parkway to the one way portion of Technology Way. This portion of road will be closed daily from Monday, September 10, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. until Friday, September 21, 2018 at 2:30 p.m. Entrances to McMinn County High School, Tennessee College of Applied Technology, and businesses will still be open.

Motorists are advised to use extreme caution, watch for detour and traffic control signage, pedestrians, and work crews. Motorists should allocate additional time for traffic delays when traveling in this area.

The purpose of this closure is for sidewalk construction.
