STREET CLOSING JACKSON STREET AND WASHINGTON AVENUE

ATHENS, TENNESSEE – January 17, 2019 – The City of Athens Public Works Department announces the following street closures:

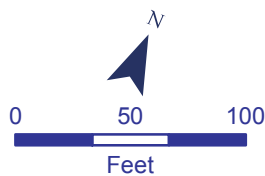
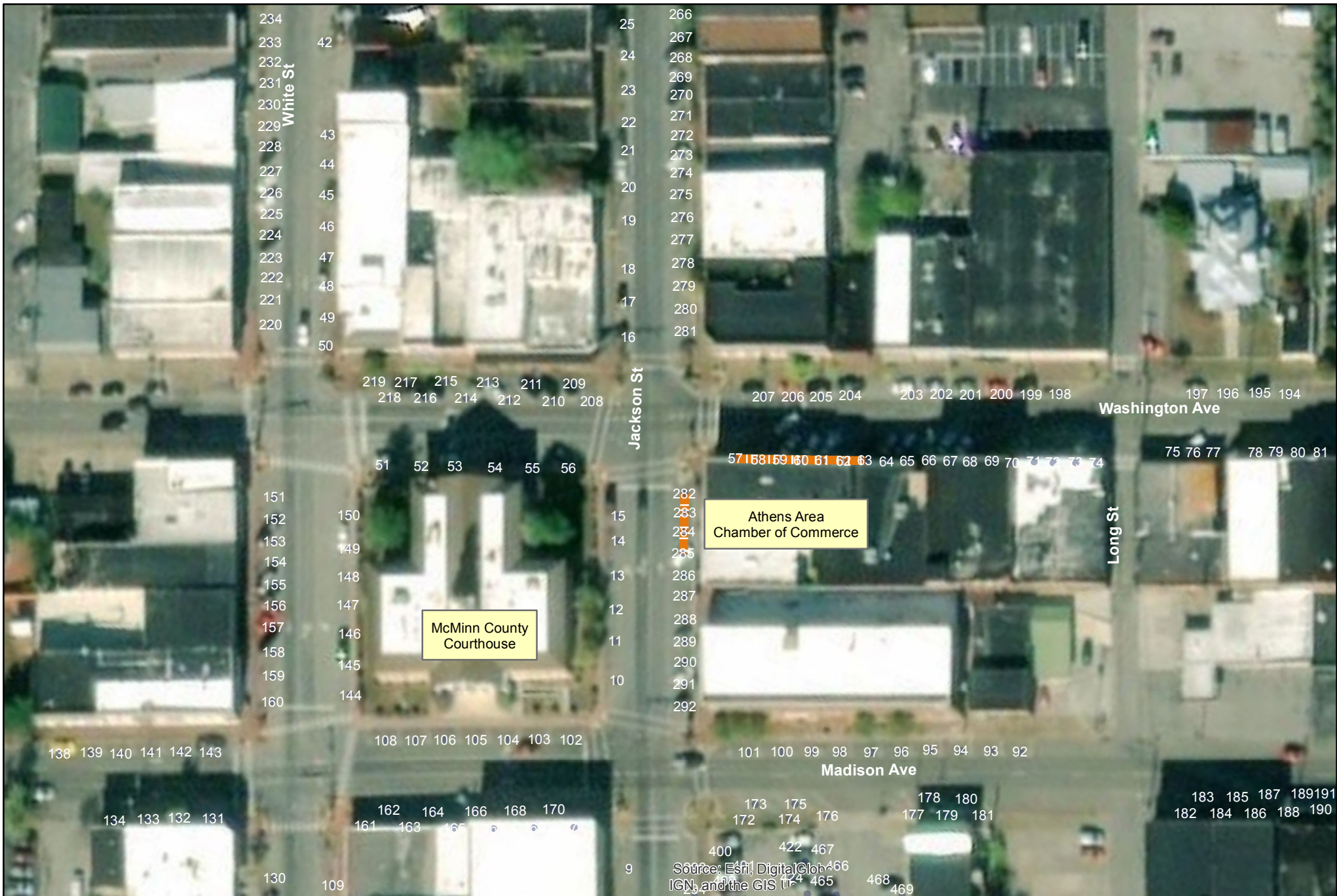
The areas to be affected are PARKING SPACES 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, and 63 on WASHINGTON AVENUE from Long Street to Jackson Street and also PARKING SPACES 282, 283, 284, and 285 on JACKSON STREET from Madison Avenue to Washington Avenue. Additionally, the sidewalk in front of these parking spaces will be closed. These closures will be from Friday, January 18, 2019 at 7:00 a.m. until Friday, February 22, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

Motorists are advised to use extreme caution, watch for detour and traffic control signage, pedestrians, and work crews. Motorists should allocate additional time for traffic delays when traveling in this area.

The purpose of this closure is for the renovation of a building.
