TRAFFIC NOTICE

SIGNAGE CHANGE TO INTERSECTION OF RAILROAD AVENUE AND TELLICO AVENUE

ATHENS, TENNESSEE – April 24, 2019 – The City of Athens Public Works Department announces the following traffic notice:

The intersection affected is TELLICO AVENUE AT RAILROAD AVENUE. Currently there are STOP signs located on Tellico Avenue. Effective THURSDAY, MAY 2, 2019 AT 7:00 A.M. there will be STOP signs in place on RAILROAD AVENUE. This will make the intersection a 4-WAY STOP. The intersection will be a temporary 4-Way STOP until the Tennessee Department of Transportation's contractor completes the installation of traffic signal lights.

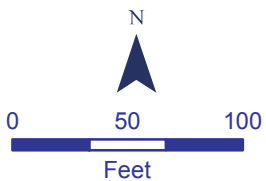
Motorists are advised to watch for new signage in this area and to use caution at this intersection.
