

Animal Shelter Technician – Public Works Dept.

This position is responsible for feeding, caring for, and interacting with shelter dogs and cats, cleaning the dog kennels, cat rooms and general shelter areas (including sweeping, mopping, scooping litter boxes, etc.), assisting the McMinn Regional Humane Society as necessary, and assisting in caring for sick/injured, and aggressive animals. Other duties include scheduling intakes and basic medical care of animals.

A high school education or equivalent is preferred. Related work experience is preferred. Must possess a valid TN driver's license. This is a full-time position with an hourly rate of \$16.59 PLUS BENEFITS.
